NOTIFICATION

No. AR-85/2009.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the General Arunachal Pradesh Group 'D' (Non-Ministerial) Common Recruitment Rules, 2009 in so far as they relate to the post of Barber/Cook/Washer man/Cobbler under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely :

1. **Short title and commencement :** (1) These rules may be called the **General Arunachal Pradesh Barber/Cook/Washer man/Cobbler Group - 'C' (Non-Ministerial) Common Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2009.**

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

**Amendment of the Schedule :** (i) in rule (3) and the Schedule annexed to the rules in column (4), for the word "scale of pay" the words "Pay Band and Grade Pay/Pay Scale shall be substituted.

(ii) In the Schedule:-

- (a) for the Entries "Group D" in column 3, the entries "Group C" shall be substituted.
- (b) for the Entries in column 4, the entries "Pay Band - Rs. 5200-20, 200, Grade Pay Rs. 1800" - shall be substituted.
- (c) for the Entries in column 8, the entries "matriculation/ITI/equivalent" shall be substituted.

## NOTIFICATION

No. AR-175/10/I.— In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Arunachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the General Arunachal Pradesh Group 'C' (Non-Ministerial) Common Recruitment Rules, 2008 in so far as they relate to the post of Barber/Cook/Washer man/Cobbler under the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement :** (1) These rules may be called the General Arunachal Pradesh Barber/Cook/Washer man/Cobbler Group 'C' (Non-Ministerial) Common Recruitment (Amendment) Rules, 2011.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Arunachal Pradesh Gazette.

3. **Amendment :** In the Barber/Cook/Washer man/Cobbler Common Recruitment Rules, 2008 for column No. 11 the following shall be substituted namely :-

(a) 75% by direct recruitment. Recruitment shall be made on the basis of the merit achieved on the following subjects :-

1. General English	---	100 Marks.
2. General Knowledge	---	100 Marks.
3. Elementary Mathematics	---	100 Marks.
4. Viva-voce	---	40 Marks.
<b>Total</b>	<b>---</b>	<b>340 Marks</b>

Note : Minimum marks shall be as per Office Memorandum No. OM 54/06 dated 7th January, 2008.

(c) 25% posts shall be appointed from the serving contingent Staff who have put in a minimum of 20 years and more continuous service.

Note : Appointment of the 25% contingency posts shall be as per the provisions of the OM No. AR-176/10 dated 15th February, 2011.

Note : The Principal rules were published in the Gazette of Arunachal Pradesh vide Department of Administrative Reforms Notification No. DM-118/2008 in so far as they were subsequently amended Notification No. AR-85/2000 dated 4th June, 2010.
